Parental Responsibility

Parental responsibility (PR) is defined in law as, "All the rights, duties, powers, responsibilities and authority, which by law a parent has in relation to the child and the administration of his/her property"¹ This means that a person with parental responsibility is responsible for the care and wellbeing of their child Unless a court
